

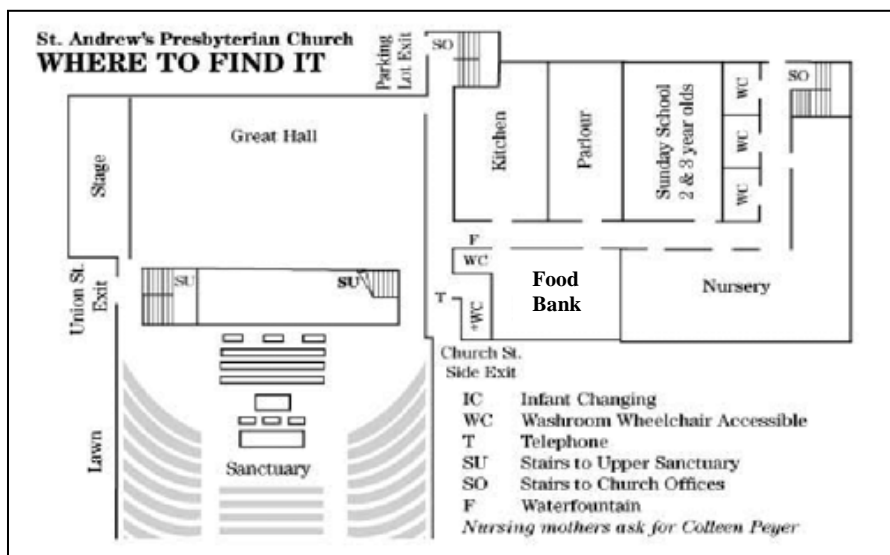
The Sacrament of Baptism
