2018 Lenten Bible Study Class The Shepherd's Psalm

Psalm 23 is often known as 'The Shepherd's Psalm.' Wikipedia tells us it is perhaps the best-known Psalm in the Old Testament Book of Psalms and is used by Jews and Christians alike. The writer, finding inspiration in a common sight in his society – a shepherd taking care of, providing for, and protecting his flock – draws a parallel between God's relationship and us. The Psalm assures us that God similarly cares for, provides for, and protects us in all circumstances.

In our study we'll look closely at each verse of the Psalm, first to see what it might have meant to the people of the time and then to apply it to our own experiences. And, in doing this, we might be enlightened – if not disconcerted! – by looking at what characteristics we have in common with sheep!

Join us as we consider these issues. Our goal is to look with fresh eyes at this familiar and much-loved Psalm and hopefully find new understandings to help us on our faith journey. The course will end with a brief Communion service, followed by our annual Bread 'n Soup lunch. All are welcome!
