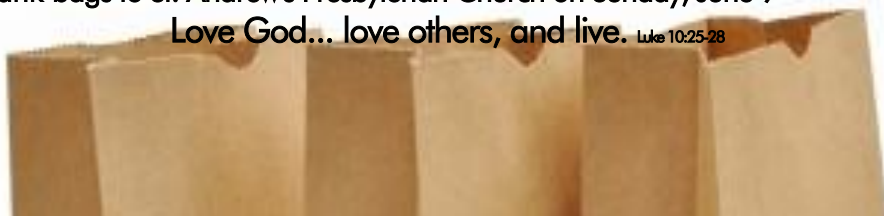


Food Bank Food Drive

Brampton is the location of the Ontario Correctional Institute. The downtown is the location to several social-service, prison related, organizations that seek to help and assist the men who are released after serving their sentence. St. Andrew's also hosts several groups to help those who struggle with not re-offending. Over the past few years we've donated over 50 Backpacks! This year – as we hope to **be the church** – we are hoping to make up as many backpack hygiene kits as we can.
