Group Study - 2:

Question 1) The Gospel of Mark begins with a message of urgency – "the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news." How 'urgent' is your faith? Has Mark's sense of urgency faded over time, or does this message still resonate today?

Question 2) Our reading today has Jesus performing His first miracles and records how excited the people of Capernaum became: do you think that the world is too jaded to get excited in the same way again? How would you respond? What are you views on miracles? Do they happen?

Question 3) Mark 1:15 began our reading saying: "the kingdom of God has come near." What is your vision of the kingdom of God – of heaven? Can it happen here? What would it take to do that?
