Dear Members and Friends of St. Andrew's:

In so many ways, the past year and a half has been hard on all of us. It has been 20 months of fear, anxiety, loneliness, and deep sadness for many of you and your families. And, as a congregation, it has been a time of emptiness as we were unable to gather in our Church building to worship. But the good news is that the waiting is over! After much preparation, on Sunday, November 7th, we held our first in-person/in-church worship service since March 8, 2020! All of this seems fitting, as preparing ourselves is the message of our upcoming Advent season!

After centuries of waiting, John the Baptist cried out Isaiah's ancient proclamation: "*Prepare ye the way of the Lord...*", calling God's waiting people to get ready for the coming of God's Son. And this is what we will be doing in our "**PREPARE YE...**" Advent series. I invite you to join us, in person or online, as together we prepare to celebrate the true meaning of Christmas!

Since many of you are still uncertain and anxious about COVID-19 and gathering together – even for worship – the Session wants you to know that it is committed to continuing the broadcasting of our worship services live online on Facebook and to reposting it on our website for you to watch if you miss it live. For those of you who wish to join us in-person for worship, we're waiting to welcome you. Before you come, though, there are several protocols that you must follow to ensure everyone's safety.
