### **Session 1: Tues., November 30<sup>th</sup>**    *The Promise*

#### **Question 1)      The Seed of Eve.** (Genesis 3:15)

As God was cursing and expelling Adam and Eve from Eden, God made the first "promise" that one day a "Son of Eve" - a Saviour - would defeat Satan and death. Have you ever experienced a crisis or tragedy, as well as a "promise" of hope at the same time? If you feel comfortable in sharing, did you feel that God was present in that moment?

#### **Question 2)      A Spokesman for God.** (Deuteronomy 18:18)

What are your thoughts about "Predictions" and "Prophecies"? Some people say that they are 'wishful thinking'; others, 'false hope.' What are your thoughts about them? Did anyone make a "prediction" or "prophecy" about you - or about something else: did it come true?

#### **Question 3) Stable-Born.** (Micah 5:2)

As we start our look at the many "Prophecies" that foretold or predicted the coming of Jesus; what do they mean to your faith in Jesus as the Son of God? Do they - or did they - help you believe? What role do these "Prophecies" that 'came true' play in your faith?
