Session 1: Tues., March 1<sup>st</sup>: Introduction: The City of Jerusalem

Group Study - 1:

Question 1) When you think about Jesus' last days, what comes to mind? What sort of image do you have in your head about Jerusalem and the places where Jesus spent His last hours?

Question 2) "Jerusalem" means "City of peace." When you think of a peaceful place – maybe it's a place that you have visited – what made that place peaceful? Do you think a city can be 'peaceful'?

Question 3) If Jesus said – and knew – that "*Jerusalem, Jerusalem, [was a] city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it!*" (Luke 13:34) Why did He "*set his face to go to Jerusalem*"? (Luke 9:51) Have you ever gone somewhere where you knew things would be hard?
