Prior to their return, the Property Committee will be meeting with each group to bring them up to date with the changes that have taken place at St. Andrew's.

With these – and last month's changes regarding the protocols surrounding masks and worship – the Session wants to assure you that your safety and health remain its primary concern. It continues to ask those who are attending In-Person/In-Church worship – or our various groups and activities – to do what *"feels right for you"* when it comes to your safety and health, and to respect and acknowledge that not everyone has the same comfort threshold when it comes to public gatherings just yet. Above all, it hopes that St. Andrew's is to be a *"Mask Friendly Space"* for all to feel safe and at home. As we have been asking since we resumed In-Person/In-Church worship, Session reminds you to not attend in-person worship if you are not feeling well.
